London, situated in the old workshop of Pre-Raphaelite painter Lawrence Alma Tadema, in the Abbey Road area of London. Steeped in history and prestige, the site is classed as a historic monument, so the guiding principle behind the décor was to preserve the historic, architectural, and emotional characteristics of the space.

A glorious cupola of the former workshop was redone in platinum leaf; the original arches preserved in the entry and the entire flow of the spaces and the layout of the rooms, has that feeling of having been preserved in harmony. Moreover, adding a mix of styles and periods, integrating the clients' own collection of art, and selecting materials to refine it all to

complement each period to suite the wishes of the owners, seemed easy for the skilled master designer and her team.

Using the works of skilled French and international designer artisans, the project literally shines with perfection.
