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Cheval Blanc Courchevel The Epitome Of Mountain Elegance



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
Cheval Blanc Courchevel is probably the most beautiful palace of the French Alps. Tucked away in the renowned French ski station Courchevel in Savoy, Cheval Blanc Courchevel, part of the LVMH group, was awarded the palace distinction in 2011. Located in the largest ski area in the world "Les 3Vallées", 85% of the domain is above 1800 meters, 600 kilometers of ski slopes and one ski pass for the seven resorts including Meribel, Val Thorens, Les Menuires, the property is the most exclusive ski destination.

Very easy access: the altiport is located about 5 minutes drive from the hotel. Welcomed by the magnificent and giant "Horse of Mirrors" of contemporary artist Bruno Peinado, the reflective emblem of the resort already gives the tone of the wooden chalet retreat with its luminous ochre-coloured facade.

Opened in 2006, Cheval Blanc Courchevel, the first one of the Cheval Blanc collection which includes St Barths, Randheli in Maldives, St Tropez, and Paris has been the reference for the following projects. Conceived as a contemporary and very warm refuge, Cheval Blanc Courchevel offers only 36 rooms and suites. Behind a typical wooden mountain facade, guests experience a very modern, extremely comfortable and ultra refined chalet without artifice.

The excellent service reflects Cheval Blanc's codes, luxurious, discreet with a meticulous attention to details, as in its design. Interior architect Sybille de Margerie who has been working with Cheval Blanc since the beginning of the adventure describes the interiors of the property as "a luxury of immaterial dimension and non-ostentatious comfort". "We committed ourselves to designing the property differently from what existed in the mountains, we broke the codes". A pioneer in mountain hospitality where rustic and mountain decoration predominates. "It is a property you need to experience, to make your own", said the architect. Inside the property, Sybille de Margerie mixed unseen materials like Murano glass or Zerbano marble, texture and colors which call emotions. She associated bright colors like green anise, ultra violet, pepsi orange or poppy red with brownish grey, the signature color of Cheval Blanc.
